Kindergarten • Use lines like an Artist

We will look at ways artists use lines and then use different lines to make art.

- Anchor standard 2: Organize and Develop Artistic ideas and work.
- Enduring Understanding: Artists and Designers experiment with forms, structures, concepts, media and art making approaches.
- Essential Question: How do artists work?
- VA:Cr2.1.Ka Through Experimentation build skills in various media and approaches to art making.

1st Grade • Georgia O'Keefe Flowers – Let's Draw BIG!

Let's look at small pieces, then make them big!

- Anchor Standard 1: Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work
- Enduring Understanding: Artists and designers shape artistic investigations, following or breaking with traditions in pursuit of creative art making goals.
- Essential Question: How do artists determine what resources and criteria are needed to formulate artistic investigations?
- VA:Cr1.2.1a Use observation and investigation in preparation for making a work of art

2nd Grade • Piet Mondrian Uses Colors

We will explore color by examining works of this famous artist and then try some art of our own.

- Anchor Standard 1: Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work.
- Enduring Understanding: Creativity and innovative thinking are essential life skills that can be developed.
- Essential Question: What conditions, attitudes, and behaviors support creativity and innovative thinking?
- VA:Cr1.2.2a Make art or design with various materials and tools to explore personal interests, questions, and curiosity.

3rd Grade • Numbers as Art

Focus on art of Jasper Johns, Charles Demuth, Robert Indiana.

- Anchor Standard 1: Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work.
- Enduring Understanding: Creativity and innovative thinking are essential life skills that can be developed.
- Essential Question(s): What conditions, attitudes, and behaviors support creativity and innovative thinking? What factors prevent or encourage people to take creative risks? How does collaboration expand the creative process?
- VA:Cr1.1.3a Elaborate on an imaginative idea.

4th, 5th, or 6th Grade • Impressionism

Explore how the Impressionists used color to make art full of bright colors

4th, 5th, or 6th Grade • Optical Illusion Art

How can we trick our eyes and make fun art?

- Anchor Standard 2: Organize and develop artistic ideas and work.
- Enduring Understanding: Artists and designers experiment with forms, structures, materials, concepts, media, and art-making approaches
- Essential Question(s): How do artists work? How do artists and designers determine whether a particular direction in their work is effective? How do artists and designers learn from trial and error?
- VA:Cr2.1.4a Explore and invent art-making techniques and approaches.
- VA:Cr2.1.5a Experiment and develop skills in multiple art-making techniques and approaches through practice.
