2025-2026 School Field Trips – National Core Arts Standards/Visual Arts

All field trips are suitable for any size of group (20-120) and can be customized based on your needs. Don't see a topic you want? With enough advance notice, you can work with our education specialist to develop a custom lesson.

Kindergarten • Positive and Negative Space

Students will explore positive and negative space by experimenting with different materials and tools to create their own unique artwork.

ANCHOR STANDARD 2: Develop and Refine Artist Techniques and K-2. VA.2.1 Experiment with various materials and tools to create a work of art or design

1st Grade • Hot Air Balloons - Elements of Art

Students will expand their art knowledge by creating crazy and wacky hot air balloons with the elements of art.

ANCHOR STANDARD 4: Respond to Artistic Work K-2 VA.4.2 Interpret art by identifying subject after and describing relevant details

2nd Grade • Pop art - Emphasis

Studenys will explore emphasis and how it came about in the world of Pop Art.

ANCHOR STANDARDS 1: Develop and create artistic ideas and work K-2 VA.1.1 Use observation and investigation in preparation for making a work of art

3rd Grade • Zentangle - Pattern and Line

Students will learn a new and fun way to create art that is also a great way to calm your body. ANCHOR STANDARDS 4: Respond to Artistic work 3-5. VA.4.1 Analyze or evaluate components in visual imagery that convey massages, ideas and mood.

4th Grade • Optical Illusions

Students will explore optical illusions by design their own illusion-inspired artwork.

ANCHOR STANDARDS 1: Develop and create artistic ideas and work 3-5. VA. 1.1 Brainstorm multiple approaches to create a work of art.

5th or 6th Grade • Decorate a room - One Perspective

Students will learn one-point perspective and decorating a room to refine their artistic skills. ANCHOR STANDARD 2: Develop and Refine Artist Techniques 6-8 VA. 2.1 Develop skills with various materials, methods, and approaches in creating works of art or design.

Group/School Policy
