



2024-2025 School Field Trips – National Core Arts Standards/Visual Arts

All field trips are suitable for any size of group (20-120) and can be customized based on your needs. Don't see a topic you want? With enough advance notice, you can work with our education specialist to develop a custom lesson.

Kindergarten • Mural Art

We will read *Maybe Something Beautiful* or *The Artist* then draw a mural and make a square for our wall.

1st Grade • Circle Art

Start with a circle... We will look at art that uses circles and make some fun circle art of our own.

2nd Grade • Teacup Elements of Art

We will draw a fun stack of teacups and add elements of art to them as we go.

3rd Grade • Surrealist Eyes

We will explore surrealism and what we see in our minds. We will focus on Rene Magritte, *The False Mirror*, and then do an art project drawing an eye.

4th, 5th, or 6th Grade • Murals and Street Art

Several cities have had community projects to help make their cities more attractive, including Idaho Falls. We will look at some cool murals, then design our own and make pieces of a big glow-in-the-dark mural.
